

Soft Painting





- 1968 Graduates from Professor Yoshishige Saito's class at Tama Art University, Tokyo.
- 1969 Receives competition prize at the 1st International Sculpture Exhibition at Hakone Open-Air Museum.
- 1983 Receives Tokyo Metropolitan Art Museum Prize at the 16th Contemporary Art Exhibition of Japan. Exhibits the work at the 3rd Henry Moore Grand Prix, achieves Utsukushigahara Highland Museum Prize.
- 1984 Worked at Isamu Noguchi's studio in New York as an artist member of the Japanese national cultural department.
- 1985 Group Exhibition at Jack Tilton Gallery, New York; all three works are purchased by the Chrysler Museum.
- 1986 As visiting professor at Harvard University, has Solo Exhibition at Harvard University Carpenter Center for the Visual Arts.
- 1987 Produced the Monuments for Kirin Yokohama beer Village, Yokohama.
- 1993 Exhibition at Ikeda 20th Century Museum, Shizuoka Prefecture, Japan.
